





Bumblebee Hand Puppet

You will need:

Coloured felt (Black, yellow and possibly white or red for the tail)
Greaseproof paper
Fabric glue
Scissors
Wiggle Eyes
4x black pipe cleaners



Instructions

Stapler

- 1. Cut out the templates for the bumblebee body and wings.
- 2. Draw around the body template onto black felt and cut out two body shapes (A & B).
- 3. Draw around the wing templates onto greaseproof paper and cut out the four wings. You can draw lines on your wings to make them look more realistic.
- 4. Cut out stripes in different coloured felt (yellow, white and/ or red) and stick these to on to body shape A with glue or staples.
- 5. Stick the large wings on top of the stripes and then stick the smaller wings on top of the larger wings. Secure with glue or staples.
- 6. Stick on the eyes.
- 7. Bend one of the pipe cleaners and staple it to the head to make the antennae.
- 8. Bend the remaining three pipe cleaners and staple these to the under-side of body shape B so that the bumblebee has six legs.
- 9. On the opposite side of body shape B put glue around the edge, except around the tail you will need to be able to put your hand in here. Stick body shape A on top to make your puppet glove. Leave the glue to dry. Alternatively, use staples instead of glue.


