Open Farm Day & Walk

Join us for a walk around Home Farm in Somerset to find out more about the species you can find in the arable habitat.

Join Daisy Headley from the Bumblebee Conservation Trust and Alison Mitchell from Plantlife to learn about England's rarest Bee, the Shrill Carder Bee and some of our rarest arable plants from Spreading Hedge-parsley to Corn Buttercup.

Focus will be placed upon understanding the needs and requirements of these species, how providing for them can benefit you & your land and ways in which both can be provided for harmoniously. The morning will involve a short introduction followed by a walk and talk around the host farm finishing off with an informal Q&A session over a light lunch back at the barn.
