



How to complete your survey

- Choose a space within your bumblebee-friendly area to survey. If your area is small, such as a pot or small planter, you may want to survey the whole area. If your space is larger, you can choose a section of the area to survey.
- Measure the size of your survey area in square metres.
- Take some time to note down all of the **different flower colours** in your bumblebee-friendly area, in the 'flower colour' column.
- Spend **10 minutes** in your survey area, watching for bumblebees.
- When you see a bumblebee, record the **colour of its tail** next to the appropriate flower colour.
